



TIME CLOCK PROGRAMMING INSTRUCTIONS

1. TO PROGRAM CLOCK

- Press and hold 'change' and 'program' buttons until display goes blank, this resets the clock and timer, the clock and day marker will now flash.
- Press 'change' to select required day, press 'program' to set day and move to hours.
- Press 'change' to select hours then 'program' to set and move to minutes.
- Press 'change' to select minutes the 'program' to set.
- The display now goes to program mode and flashes 'ON' follow steps below to program on/off times.

2. TO PROGRAM ON/OFF TIMES

- Press 'change' to advance the day to the required setting, which are:-
 - = Mon – Fri
 - = Sat & Sun
 - = Mon – Sun
 - = Individual days, starting with Mon through to Sun.
 - a) Press program to set the day and select hour for ON time.
 - b) Press change to advance hours
 - c) Press program to set hours and select minutes
 - d) Press change to advance minutes
 - e) Press program to set minutes
- The display now goes blank and flashes 'Off'

3. TO SET THE OFF TIMES repeat steps 2b – 2e

- For the remaining 5 ON/OFF programs repeat steps 2 - 2e if no other ON/OFF times are required press and hold program until the display returns to time display.

4. TO CHANGE PROGRAM/TIME

- Press program – display flashes
- Press change – you are now in program mode, to change time or programs follow steps above.

5. TO CANCEL PROGRAMS

- Go into program mode step 4 and change ON/OFF time until display shows - - : Press program to clear. This must be done for both ON & OFF times.

6. REVIEW OF PROGRAMS

- Press and hold 'program'. The display will scroll showing all ON/OFF times.

7. OVERRIDE IN TIMED MODE

- Manual override in timed mode can be achieved by pressing 'change' this will either switch the unit on or off depending on which state the unit is in initially on or off. The output will flash to indicate override.

NOTE: If the clock is set within a program ON time the unit will not switch on. Use the change button to switch the unit on, after this the unit will operate normally to the programmed times.
